The camps will be supervised by Maestro Les Stawicki and assisted by Coach Orion Bazzell. Maestro Stawicki is the former head coach of the Polish Olympic Team and currently head coach of the U.S. Paralympic Fencing Team. Cost of the camp is \$250/week and student must bring a lunch.
